


GUIDED TOURS TO ONE OF THE MOST EXTENSIVE AND VALUABLE ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES IN THE CANARY ISLANDS: EL JULAN

The Cultural Park El Julan has regulations for the conservation of the archaeological heritage, so it is important to follow the instructions of the staff and the signposting at all times.

Reservations must be made at least one day in advance.

This guided tour is not included in the El Hierro Tourist Passport.

MIXED ROUTE

Departure at 8:00 a.m. - Maximum group size of 7 persons.

Outbound on foot, return by vehicle.

Estimated duration of 4 hours / High difficulty / Average walking distance of 6 km.

CAR ROUTE

Departure at 9:00 a.m. - Maximum group size of 8 persons.

Estimated duration of 4 hours / Medium-high difficulty / Average distance of 11 km.

IMPORTANT: People with cardiovascular problems or walking difficulties should refrain from doing this activity.

RULES AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT FOR THE VISIT TO EL JULAN


We recommend that you carefully read the following indications to carry out the route to the archaeological site of El Julan properly.





Punctuality: We kindly ask you to respect the assigned time. Your punctuality is essential for the development of the visits. Delays may adversely affect the planned timetable.





Clothing: It is recommended to wear a cap, sun protection, water, warm clothing (depending on the season) and suitable footwear (hiking or sports shoes). The staff could exclude you from the route if they find that your footwear is unsuitable for the excursion.


 Always follow the guide's instructions and do not take unmarked routes or stray from the group.

 If you experience fatigue, dizziness or discomfort, notify the guide immediately.


 Children under 11 years of age are not allowed to participate in the route.


 Provisions: Water and some snacks are recommended (no long stops for lunch).

 Hiking poles are strictly forbidden, except for poles covered with rubber on the ground end.


 It is not allowed to collect any type of material from the environment. Remember that you are entering a protected archaeological environment.

 Do not leave any garbage behind during the tour.


 Smoking is not allowed during the tour.

 Right of admission: We reserve the right of admission to allow entry or stay, both in the center and during the tour. The guides could exclude you from the visit if you are under the influence of alcohol and/or other narcotic substances, as well as if your conduct is uncivil and hinders the visit or endangers your safety or that of others.

 Pets are not allowed during the tour.

 In case of adverse weather conditions, the service could be suspended at the start of the tour, according to the guide's discretion.

How to get there:

 Head to El Pinar, take the road that leads you to Hoya del Morcillo. Once there, continue along the HI-400 road towards La Dehesa.

Take the first turnoff you find on your left indicating Cultural Park of El Julian.

Total distance 9.5 km, 19 min.
